- Not-for profit
- Not personally owned or for personal financial gain
- Serving the community of Thaxted
- Located in the parish of Thaxted.

Your application will be assessed by the Trustees / Committee of the Trust during January. The success of all applications and the amount of each grant subsequently distributed is entirely at the discretion of the Trustees / Committee of the Trust. Distributions will be made by the end of February. Applications for funding for a major project or where the timing of funding is significant may be made out with the normal application period and will be considered at the discretion of the Trustees / Committee.
